Size of the stump was about 2mx1m and 2m high.



## 1<sup>st</sup> step: try to find the head of the dragon.



2<sup>nd</sup> step: Left wing and starting the body.







# 3<sup>rd</sup> step: right wing





Step 4 and 5: drafting the tail and adding the bench. The bench originates from a branch of the same tree.
